

- Candidate should be medically fit to work in different areas of the state including high altitude zones.
- All the interested candidates and having required/ essential educational qualification may attend walk-in-interview on 08.11.2016 starting at **10.30 AM** in the Video Conferencing (VC) Room of the institute. The registration of the candidates will be start **9.30 AM to 10.00 AM** failing which no application will be accepted. Candidates are to deposit their C.V. (giving details of Name, Date of birth, Father's Name, Permanent & Current Address, Educational qualification from High School/ Higher Secondary onwards with the name of Institution, Year of Passing, Marks obtained, Medium of study and field experience, with one passport size colour photograph affixed on it). They are also requested to attach self-attested photocopies of all the testimonials along with the application. The original mark-sheets, certificates, experience certificates etc are also required to be brought alongwith for verification on the day of interview.
- Separate applications are to be submitted for each of the position; otherwise their candidature is liable to be rejected.
- Age in case of JRF/JPF should not exceed 28 years as on dated of interview. Relaxation in age to SC/ST/OBC will be given as per rules
- In case of Project Assistant and Field Assistant, age should not be more than 35 years.
